- Immediately and intentionally receive what God has revealed to you (Mark 4:24)
- Ask God for wisdom and grace to apply what you have heard (James 1:5)
- Make a daily decision to obey everything the Spirit and the Word speak (Matthew 4:4)
- Be tenacious to apply the word of God even when circumstances remain contrary (2 Corinthians 4:18)
- Guard your mouth daily to speak only life-giving words (Proverbs 18:21, John 6:63)
