

The Holy Spirit is My Friend

It has been nine years since I had what I would describe as a life changing encounter with the Holy Spirit. Since, that life changing encounter my life long desire has been to come to know the Holy Spirit. I have always wanted to be friend of God. Over the last few months my desire for intimacy with him has brought me to place I have never thought possible. I believe it is the will of God to bring every believer to live a life of intimacy they never thought possible. The primary reason we were born to be lovers of God and to gaze upon his beauty. I challenge you today to set aside time each day to share and to partake of the wonders of knowing God. God has promised us in his word that he would manifest himself to his children. The fruit of I have yet to meet a friend of God who lives a defeated, stationary Christian life. While I have learned much in my times of divine encounter with the Holy Spirit, I just want to briefly share three fruits that will result in your life if you chose to live a life on intimacy with God. The place of intimacy is the place of receiving revelation knowledge:

In these strategic times in which we live, as the people of God we must have a continual flow of revelation knowledge to our hearts, and our minds. The Apostle Paul wrote in his letter to the Romans in chapter twelve verse two that as believers we are to be “transformed by the renewing of our minds.” Revelation knowledge opens the door so that be we can transformed to be the supernatural, overcoming people God has created us to be. The spirit of revelation is also released upon those who are willing to come hungry and desperate (those who desire to know him). There are great truths hidden in the word for the people of God, and it comes to the people of God by revelation knowledge.

The place of intimacy is the place of a continual encounter with the father heart of God:

We were made to be lovers not workers. The place of divine encounter with the Holy Spirit is a place of coming to know him as father God. God has great plans of prosperity and goodness for our life, but his primary interest, is that his people come into sonship with the father. We are relieved of the pressures of life (i.e. of having to have successful career/ministries, to please others, prove something to our parents) when we gain our identity by simply being sons and daughter of almighty God. The Apostle Paul put it best in Romans chapter eight verse fifteen “For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, Abba, Father.”

The place of intimacy is the foundation to living an overcoming lifestyle:

When one continually partakes of drinking of the fountain of living water, there is a rest one can enter into as a believer. It does not matter if you are facing a hopeless situation, or if all seems lost. The place of intimacy is a place of peace and joy. Jesus told his disciples in John chapter fifteen verse eleven “These things I have spoken to you, and that your joy may be full.” Perhaps you need healing in your body, or healing from past hurts as you begin to enter into intimacy with the father the Holy Spirit will heal your hurts. The place of intimacy also allows us to see from God’s perspective, and God’s perspective always sees his people walking through every situation as a victor!
